Question: What positions are open?

Answer: President, Vice-President, Secretary and three (3) At Large Board Members.. Each Officer will serve a 2 year term unless there are extenuating circumstances Each At Large Board member will serve a one (1) year term unless there are extenuating circumstances.

Question: I am a new member effective 2024, can i participate in the upcoming election?

Answer; Sorry.. But.no.We feel that we need experienced Club members on the Board. You can sit in and observe the proceedings, however you would have the opportunity to nominate and vote next year.

Question: What is the nomination process this year?

Answer: Members may (1) nominate themselves-Self Nominate or (2) have another member nominate him/her once the nominee has a basic understanding of the duties and responsibilities of the position All nominations should be filed with the Club Secretary preferably by Email.

Question: Why is the nomination process different than in past years?

Answer: In past years nominations were made from the floor and sometimes without prior-knowledge and approval of the nominee.. The new process should alleviate this.

Question: What questions should be asked of the Officer Nominees?

Answer: At this point in the selection process two (2) questions seem to be important: "Why do you want this position?" and "What new direction(s) would you like the Board to pursue in 2024?"

Question: How will the vote be taken?

Answer: Each position will be posted in the meeting followed by a confirmation that each nominee will serve if elected by a vote from the members present. For example the nominees for Vice President might be: Isa Goober, Iffy Can, and BooBoo with each nominee being asked if they will serve if elected. .

Question: If more than one nominee for the same position, how will the vote be taken?

Answer: Per our By-laws the election must be a secret ballot in writing. Ballots will be provided to maintain secrecy.

Question: What if there is only one nominee for a position??

Answer: In the past we have held an uncontested election whereby a nominee is elected by a motion from a club member and approved by the membership.(elected by acclamation)..

Question: How will Board Members at Large be selected?

Answer: Per our By-laws those nominees receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected.

Question: What if there is a tie involving the highest number of votes?

Answer: Voting continues until there is a simple majority or a concession or withdrawal by one of the nominees: is made which breaks the tie.
